Course Key Topic Area Includes:

Course System is based on the six levels defined in the "Common European Framework of Reference for Languages (CEFR)." The language skills students acquire in this course are internationally comparable.

The Objectives reflect the latest methods in the science of teaching and learning - are diverse and communicative. Four language skills will be practiced: Speaking, listening, reading and writing.

Main Topics:

Profession and Work – Events and activities in the past tense – In the City – Conversation in a Hotel – Health and Illnesses – Body parts – Write a letter – Ask and describe the directions – Transportations – Specify locations – Request information – quote chronological references – Express polite requests and invitations – Clothing – Shopping in a mall – Celebrations – Important dates of the year

Grammar/Structures:

Past tense, Preterite – Modal and Temporal Prepositions – Modal verbs – Imperative - Possessive Article – Local Prepositions – Conjunctive 2 – Verbs with different Prefix – Demonstrative pronoun – Question article – Comparison – Personal pronouns and verbs in Dative – Ordinal Numbers – Personal Pronouns in Accusative – Conjunction "denn"

At the end of the program the trainees will be able to:

- Exchange information about past and preset
- Report on events and activities in the past
- Understand job offers in newspapers, make phone calls
- Give instructions and advice
- Talk about allowed and forbidden rules
- Read and understand information brochures
- At the hotel reception ask for help and explanation
- Express themselves about their and others well-being
- Write simple texts, reply to an email or text message, propose an idea of weekend activities with friends using acquired vocabs and grammar skills such as conjunctions "denn, und"
- Write a simple postcard about their experiences in vacation, telling a story in the past tense, describing weather, places, new friends, activities, cultural attractions.
- Understand a speech, which is very slow delivered and includes the majority of acquired vocabs and grammar structures, with long pauses.
- Understand announcements in the train station or airport
- Express their future wishes and explain the reason, talk about the dreams with the examples
- Read, understand and write invitations for birthdays and other celebrations
